THE STORYLINE

For the second straight week, Montana State renews a series against a new Big Sky member in the first Bobcat visit to that school's stadium. Last week's visit to Eccles Coliseum produced an MSU win over Southern Utah. This week, the Cats head to Aggie Stadium for its first road trip to UC Davis. MSU and the Aggies have split two previous games. UC Davis jumped out to a 31-0 lead in whipping Weber State 37-13 last weekend, with Dalton Turay scoring three touchdowns. Quarterback Randy Wright (234.0 passing yards per game) and linebacker Byron Gruendl (39 tackles, two interceptions) lead the Aggies.

FOR OPENERS

- ✓ MSU played most of the second half vs. SUU without its leading rusher (Cody Kirk), receiver (Tanner Bleskin), and the left side of its O-line (Matthew Devereux, John Weidenaar)
- ✓ Rob Ash's 44 wins at MSU moves him to within three of the school's all-time wins record (47, Sonny Holland), which would put him on top of the wins list at three different schools
- ✓ UC Davis defensive line coach Will Kofe began his college career at MSU (2000)

STADIUM STUFF

- ✓ MSU visits two stadiums for the first time in 2012 - last week at SUU, this week at UCD

BIG SKY BULLET POINTS

- ✓ So far in 2012, Big Sky teams have wins over the Pac 12 (Sac State beat Colorado), Mountain West (NAU topped UNLV, Cal Poly beat Wyoming), and WAC (EWU beat Idaho)
- ✓ MSU leads the Big Sky in third down offense (56.8%) and defense (26.7%)

In-Season Media Policies

Practice Policy

MSU practices are generally open to the public, but media members are asked to check in with MSU Sports Info. **EVERYTHING SEEN AND HEARD AT PRACTICE IS OFF THE RECORD.** Photography and videography are never permitted after the first 30 minutes.

Player Interviews

MSU players are available **ONLY** on Tuesdays during normal game week at the Bobcat Media Lunch (12-1 pm, Hall of Fame Room). Players not at the Media Lunch are available after practice (in-person interviews only), while those asked to attend the pizza lunch won't be asked to do post-practice interviews. Players are **NEVER** available for interviews on Monday, or after Tuesday. Per Rob Ash's policy, true freshmen are not available for interviews.

Rob Ash Interviews

Rob Ash is available during the weekly Media Lunch (Tuesdays, noon). Other interviews are by arrangement through MSU Sports Info, but generally Wednesdays from 10 am to noon. Rob Ash is available on the Big Sky coaches conference call each Wednesday at 10:15 am (866-398-2885, Passcode 517644). Coach Ash is available on game days only following the contest.

Injury Updates

MSU issues injury reports on Sunday night, Tuesday, and before and after each game. Per school policy, MSU updates the player, injury, and status for upcoming game.

Post-Game Interviews

Up to four requested players appear in the former visiting team house in Bobcat Stadium's NW corner 15 minutes or so after the game.

Sideline Photo Policies

Bobcat Stadium photographers are allowed behind the 10-foot limit line, **EXCEPT** in team areas or when obstructing the view of paying customers. Photographers are never allowed inside the blue pads. Photo passes are issued on the following priority system: 1) Still photographers and videographers affiliated with commercial media outlets; 2) Photographers officially designated by competing institutions; and 3) Freelance and student photographers may be issued one credential to a single game during the season, based on available space.

Credential and Seating Priority

1) Daily newspapers and local television and radio news; 2) Weekly newspapers and out-of-market television and radio news; 3) Periodicals; 4) Blogs or other electronic outlets (as space allows); 5) Unaffiliated writers and photographers (as space allows).

A Quick Look

MSU vs. UC Davis

New Rivals

Montana State is hip deep into the 'new Big Sky', in the midst of a two-game stretch against first-year league mates. The Cats topped Southern Utah 24-17 in Cedar City last weekend, and visit another Big Sky newcomer, UC Davis, this week. The Bobcats have played each team twice previously, but have never visited either school before 2012. This is the first weekend the Big Sky completely integrates its new members into the mix, with Weber State, like MSU a conference charter member, hosting Cal Poly, Eastern Washington hosting North Dakota, and Sac State visiting Southern Utah. To this point, the league's new additions stand 3-1 against the old guard.

Early Returns

One common trait shared by MSU's first three league opponents - in addition to each possessing tall quarterbacks - is the presence of outstanding return men. The Cats held NC's Dominic Gunn, the Big Sky's top punt returner (22.0 per return), without a single attempt, punting only three times without a return. Southern Utah kick returner Josh Smith stands second in the Big Sky (23.0), but returned two kickoffs against MSU for just 40 total yards, with each of those two drives beginning inside the SUU 25. Next up is UC Davis' Jonathan Perkins, who leads the Big Sky in kick returns.

Hey, I Know You

For the fifth time in MSU's first six games at least one tie binds opposing coaching staffs. UC Davis defensive line coach Will Kofe began his college career at MSU in 2000, starting five mid-season games. Kofe was part of the freshman class that included current MSU linebackers coach Kane Ioane, and he 22 tackles, three for a loss. He departed for his LDS mission after that season, then completed his playing career as a part-time starter at Arizona State (2005-06). Kofe also coached at Sacramento State from 2006-09.

The Series

The story of the brief MSU-UC Davis series is one of blowouts. The Aggies hammered Montana State 45-0 in 2006, while the Bobcats responded with a 38-14 victory last season. Both games were played in Bozeman.

It's All Relative

Montana State's 2012 football team is one of strong bloodlines. In addition to the three sets of brothers on the team (Jake and Tanner Bleskin, twins Kruiz and Kazz Siewing, and Chase and Rhett Young), three Bobcats - Brad Daly (Bobby, along with father J.), Caleb Schreibeis (Joe), Brian Bignell (Clay) and Connor Verlanic (Andrew) - have brothers that played for the Cats. Also: Heath Hunter's father Alex played at UM, Jackson Mahlum's father and Cody Kirk's uncle Tom Mahlum, Nate Bignell's father Joe and Trace Timmer's father Kirk all played on MSU's 1984 National Championship team. Trace Timmer's brother Ty currently plays at Montana, while Connor Verlanic's brother Alex is a former Grizzly. And in one MSU-DU twist, freshman Bobcat offensive lineman JP Flynn's brother Steven played at Drake. He was recruited by Rob Ash, but the long-time Bulldog head man departed for Bozeman before Flynn's career began.

Bobcat Offensive Notebook

Offensive Notes

- Much of Montana State's magic early in the 2012 season has come on third down. The Bobcats lead the Big Sky in third down conversions on offense, converting such plays into first downs at a 57% clip. The Bobcats' 7-for-13 effort on third down Saturday marked the team's low output of the season, but the team has been above 50% each time out.
- In 27 games on Bobcat Stadium's artificial surface, Montana State has averaged 424.1 yards of offense (11,450 total) per game, and 32.6 points (879 total points). The turf was donated by MSU's 1984 National Championship team, which featured Jackson Mahlum's dad and Cody Kirk's uncle (Tom Mahlum), Brian Bignell's uncle and Nate Bignell's father (Joe Bignell), and Trace Timmer's father (Kirk Timmer) and uncle (Troy Timmer).
- DeNarius McGhee continues his march up MSU's career wins list. The Bobcats' junior quarterback won his 24th game at the signals vs. SUU, two from matching Paul Dennehy's school-record total of 26. His 11 TD passes this year raises his career total to 58, tied for second in school history and two behind Kelly Bradley's school record of 60.
- Senior RB Tray Robinson has only 15 carries this year, but has 18 catches.
- The Cats have been outstanding in the red zone in 2012. MSU has moved inside the opponent 20-yard line 26 times, converting 23 of those into scores (88%) and 20 into touchdowns (78%). Included in those figures are two possessions ending with the Bobcat offense kneeling to kill the clock at the end of a game.
- MSU's current starting O-line of two freshmen, a sophomore and two seniors is the team's youngest front in over since 2000, when MSU started two freshmen and one sophomore, junior and senior. One of the freshmen was future All-America Brent Swaggert. Mike Quast would start the next three seasons at guard, while Swaggert was entrenched as a four-year starter at tackle. Paul Diercks and Ryan Henning each started the next two seasons.

Defensive Notes

- Defensive tackle Brian Bignell's season may have started late, but it's picked up steam in a hurry. The senior from Helena logged two sacks among his four tackles against Northern Colorado, and at Southern Utah supplemented his one tackle with a quarterback hurry and a pass breakup.
- The 135 yards Montana State allowed against Chadron State was the fewest allowed in an MSU season opener since Adams State gained 116 yards in 2008.
- Montana State is fourth in the FCS in rushing yards allowed (63.4). In the last three games, MSU has allowed in order 59, 55, 52 and 69 rushing yards.
- The Bobcats' starting defensive line, as projected in the preseason, finally played together for the first time at Southern Utah (game five) when Zach Minter and Brian Bignell took the field together. The group responded by allowing only 69 rushing yards, adding three sacks and two pass breakups.
- Senior cornerback Darius Jones is up to his old tricks in 2012, logging four pass breakups through five games. He now has 27 PBs in his career. Safety Steven Bethley is step-for-step with Jones, sharing the team lead with three PBUs.
- Defensive end Caleb Schreiber has had his hand in key plays in each of the last four games. The senior from Billings logged a sack on third-and-10 near midfield early in the fourth quarter against Drake, and his sack on SFA's final possession resulted in a fumble recovered by Hayden Vick. He also broke up a pass against Northern Colorado while the game's outcome remained in doubt that could have ended in a touchdown. Schreiber logged a sack and forced a fumble at Southern Utah.
- Steven Bethley appears in the process of becoming the kind of playmaking safety the Bobcat defense has expected. The junior from Chino, Calif., made game-clinching interceptions late against Stephen F. Austin and Southern Utah.

Kick Team Notes

- Montana State's first field goal attempt of 2012 came 179-and-a-half minutes into its season. With 31 seconds remaining against SFA, Rory Perez converted his first field goal try as a Bobcat, a 45-yarder that gave MSU an eight-point lead against #23 Stephen F. Austin. He also converted each of the three ensuing attempts, and is 4-for-4 on the season.
- Jason Cunningham missed three extra points in 13 games last fall. In 2012, MSU has already missed three. But, Rory Perez has converted 13 straight and 16 of 17.
- Montana State's punting tandem has performed well through five games. Rory Perez averages 36.4 yards per punt and Trevor Bolton 36.2. The two have combined for nine pins inside the 20 on 22 total punts and three kicks of 50+ yards.
- Although the Bobcats stand 12th in the 13-team Big Sky in net punting (34.3 yards per kick, MSU punters Rory Perez and Trevor Bolton have allowed the lowest yards-per-return rate in the Big Sky (1.1).
- Freshman kickoff specialist AJ Silva has drilled 18 touchbacks in his 33 kick-offs this season, the second-best rate in the Big Sky (after EWU's Kevin Miller). Average starting position for Bobcat opponents after kickoffs is the 23 yard line.
- Trevor Bolton's college debut was certainly memorable. Handling place-kicking and punting chores in the opener against Chadron State, the redshirt freshman had his first two kicks (both extra points) blocked, then rallied to hit three in a row. He had a solid night punting, averaging 39.7 yards on three kicks, pinning Chadron State inside the 20 twice and booming a long of 47. Only one of Bolton's punts was returned, and that for just eight yards.

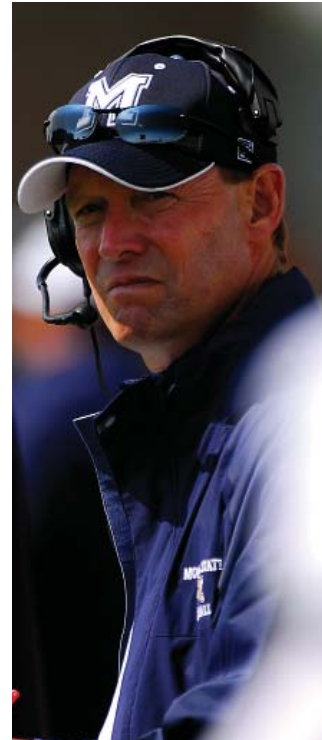

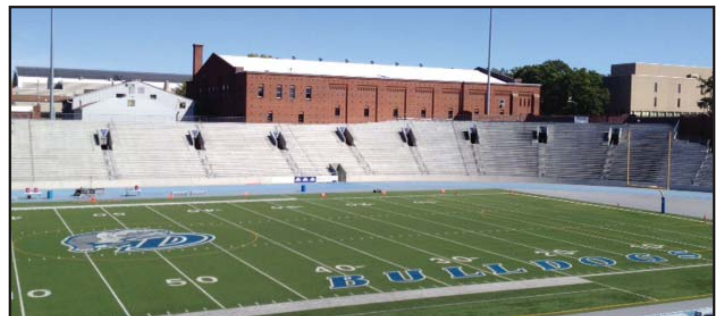
